Each year we write a School Development Plan (SDP) which is based on work from all stakeholders (parent survey, pupils, staff, governors as well as our SEP – School Evaluation Partner). During his recent visit, the SMT (Senior Management Team) talked through the priorities for this year which include developing:

- **Our High Ham curriculum framework**
- **The subject leadership skills of class teachers**
- **Our monitoring and assessment systems**
- **The Mental Health and well-being of pupils and staff (following on from the national training we will receive later this year)**

Each term these priorities are discussed with the SEP as well as at Governors meetings, so we can keep track of progress and update priorities as time goes by.

In addition, the Governance Board write a strategic plan which gives a longer-term vision for our school and is regularly updated in light of national/local priorities.
