

School Improvement Plan 2022-2023

Each year we write a School Improvement Plan (SIP) which is written to consider the views of all stakeholders (parent survey, pupils, staff, governors). We also work closely with a School Evaluation Partner (SEP) who discusses our priorities for the year. The plan has been written to incorporate the development points from our recent OFSTED inspection.

This year we will continue to develop:

- •Our High Ham Curriculum paying particular attention to the foundation subjects (Art and Design, History and Geography). Throughout this work we will look to strengthen our Personal Development teaching to ensure Fundamental British Values are shared and understood by all.
- •Subject leadership skills of class teachers particularly in developing monitoring strategies in the foundation subjects.
- •Our monitoring and assessment particularly focussing on assessment strategies that allow us to improve outcomes for all our pupils.
- •The mental health and well-being of all our stakeholders focussing on developing a well-being focus group to ensure that there is a shared understanding of this key area.

Each term, these priorities are discussed with the SEP and progress is monitored closely by the Governance Board.

The Governance Board also writes a strategic plan for the school which gives a longer-term vision. This is regularly updated considering national/local recommendations.
