Just a few reminders.

DROP OFF:

Our aim is for all children to come in on their own, please help to support this where you can. All KS1 classes have a TA to help welcome the children into class on a morning.

PICKUP:

- Wear a mask (if medically able).
- Observe social distancing.
- Only walk on to the school site when there is sufficient space.
- One adult for each family to pick up.
- Keep toddlers with you.
- Leave the school site once you have collected your child.

Some parents are concerned about the lack of adult social distancing at the gate and that parents are parking on the drop off zone. We are unable to enforce these rules and therefore I need to ask everyone to take responsibility for themselves and to be considerate towards others. When you are waiting at the gate, please remember that by being a little patient, it means your child has a full day at school.

I shall be working from home during the November lockdown. On a morning Mrs Edwards will be at the gate and then will leave promptly to register her class.

PLEASE continue to use the reading records to leave a message for the teacher if needed and use the absence telephone answer machine for any illness.

PLEASE encourage your child to complete class homework (including Google Classroom) as this helps us to ensure that everyone is in a good routine for home learning should this be needed again.
