At the time of your bubble celebration, please queue socially distanced with masks on five minutes before. The gate will open at the performance times.

#### **Can I take my children home early if they are in other classes?**

No. In order to avoid confusion on the playground this will not be possible.

Instead, following the performance please leave with your child that has just performed. Once we have cleared the site following the final performance, any parents/carers who have come to watch in the afternoon may collect their other children (if they wish) at 3pm. For those who do not have a performance that day, collection will be as usual at 3.30pm. Please leave the school site between performances, even if you are watching one after another, so that we can keep the area clear and set up.

#### **What will happen if it is raining?**

It will go ahead. The class will perform under the shelter and we will ask you to bring an umbrella. There will be plenty of room to spread out so there is no need to worry about space.

#### **Who can come and watch?**

Anyone you like.

**Do we need to wear masks?**

Yes please.

**Is there a limit in numbers?**

No. We are asking you to leave the site straight after and not wait for other siblings so that we can offer you the opportunity to bring other family members. We will expect each family bubble to stand 2m apart. Please only send one adult onto the school site if you need to collect your child from a different class at 3pm.

**If my class bubble is not performing that day what time do I pick up?**

3.30pm.

**Is it free?**

Yes.

**What does my child need to wear?**

On the day of their performance they can wear a Christmas jumper/mufti. They will be wearing their coats so they could choose to wear a festive hat if they have one.
