### **Entry in school website diary about sports days:**

At the end of the afternoon the children can go home and you can take siblings should you wish.

NB: If dry, this will go ahead as planned with families attending. If wet, the children will take part in indoor sports activities and families will not attend.

### **Additional Information in the light of latest Covid guidelines:**

- On the day, if it is raining we will tweet and no families will be invited.
- Please wear masks for times when you cannot social distance. For example, on way in, when purchasing refreshments.
- There will be colour zones on the field, please sit in these areas in family groups socially distanced from each other and then masks will not need to be worn whilst watching.
- There will be some shaded areas but please bring hats, cover up (and sun umbrellas if you wish) if it is really hot as we need to keep in our four colour teams.
- Each team will have the opportunity to visit the PTA stand in their colour teams.
- At the end please collect any siblings and leave the school site.
- Please keep younger children sat with you. Siblings in other classes will not be coming out to watch as we are running sports day over six days it would be too disruptive to class teachers to have pupils missing from each class each afternoon.
