A very important part of Pinkery is the food!

Breakfast is usually cereal and toast with a special 'leaving' breakfast on the last day.

Lunch is made by the children and consists of a sandwich, fruit, cereal or cake bar and a packet of crisps.

Sleep!

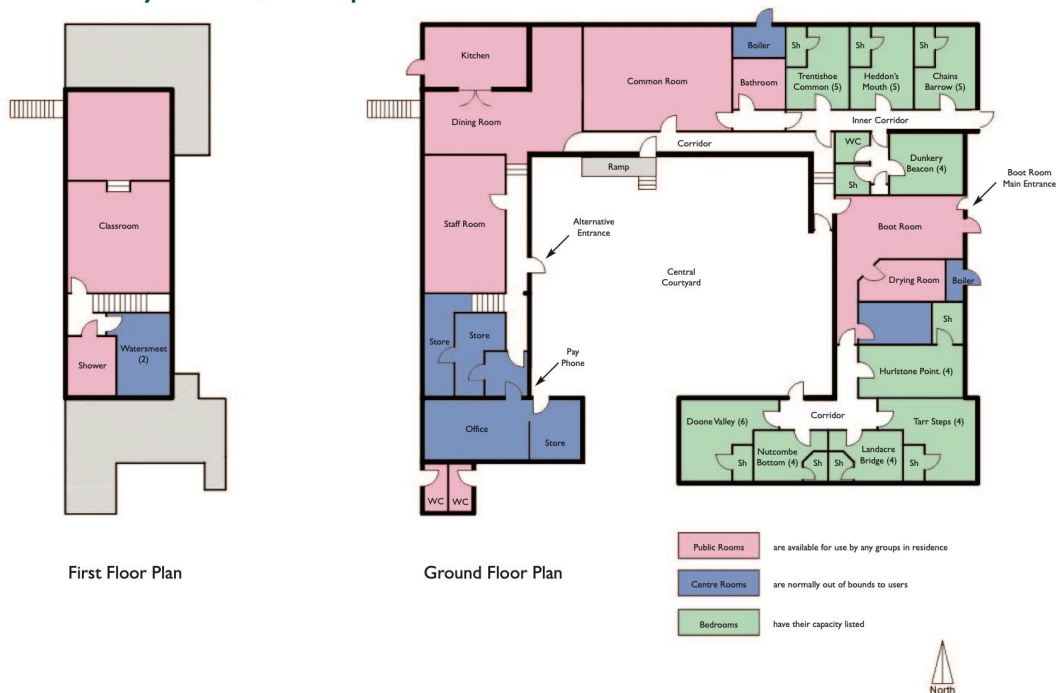
The dorms have between four and six beds. I choose the groupings for each room and take into account all the different personalities.
