

Covid Update 18th October 2021

Thank you for your support with following our Covid guidelines. The latest update is always on the front page of the website.

Oct national Information - UK Health Security Agency (UKHSA) have been made aware of some areas reporting positive LFD test results with subsequent negative PCR tests and are currently looking into the cause. Whilst the UKHSA investigation is under-way, we advise that if a pupil or staff member has been in close contact with a positive case (such as a household member) or has displayed Covid-19 symptoms and has tested positive on an LFD (but subsequently tested negative on a PCR), they are treated as potentially infectious. We recommend they isolate and remain out of the setting, for 10 days.

Parents and Families

- (1) Wearing a face mask is currently a personal choice. We will continue to ask all visitors to wear masks when working within our school. Staff/Adults will also be encouraged to wear masks during meetings. *NB: Please be mindful that the Health Secretary has said mandatory face masks might be reintroduced.*



- (2) 3.30pm pick up for all. Please pick up and leave the school site quickly and keep younger siblings with you.
- (3) From October, all children to come in on their own on a morning.

(4) Notify the school office of any absences and details of PCR tests. Online work will be provided for those isolating, if they are well enough to work.
